<p style="text-align: center;">ORDER PURSUANT TO C.R.S. § 6-1-109(1) ENFORCING COMPLIANCE WITH ATTORNEY GENERAL SUBPOENAS AND GRANTING INJUNCTIVE RELIEF RESTRAINING THE SALE OR ADVERTISEMENT OF SERVICES</p>	

THIS MATTER comes before the Court on the Petitioner’s motion for relief under C.R.S. § 6-1-109(1) to remedy Respondents’ failure to comply with two subpoenas *duces tecum*, dated December 16, 2010, issued by the Colorado Attorney General pursuant to its pre-filing civil investigative authority under C.R.S. § 6-1-108(1) of the Colorado Consumer Protection Act, and being fully advised in the premises,

ORDERS that pursuant to C.R.S. § 6-1-109(1)(a), Respondents are hereby enjoined and restrained from the sale or advertisement of any mortgage assistance relief services until five (5) days after the date on which Respondents fully comply with the subpoenas *duces tecum* and after the date on which Respondent Gregory G. Vernon appears for his examination. Respondents are also ordered pursuant to C.R.S. § 6-1-109(1)(b) to produce all the documents requested in the two subpoenas *duces tecum*, dated December 16, 2010, within five (5) days of this order, and Respondent Gregory G. Vernon must appear for this examination under oath at the Attorney General’s office no later than fifteen (15) days from this order.

Pursuant to C.R.S. § 6-1-113(4), the Court awards the Attorney General attorney fees and costs for successfully enforcing article 1 of the Colorado Consumer Protection Act by having to seek this relief. The Attorney General shall submit an affidavit of fees and costs within fifteen (15) days of the order.
